## TENDER FOR SUPPLY, IMPLEMENTATION AND SUPPORT OF AN INTEGRATED SOFTWARE SYSTEM

The Coffee Development Fund (CoDF) is a state corporation under the Ministry of Agriculture established under the Coffee Act No. 9 of 2001.

The Fund is vested with the responsibility of providing sustainable, affordable credit to coffee farmers for farm development, farm inputs, farming operations and price stabilization.

The Fund, which is in the process of automating its operations to fulfil its obligations, invites Technical and Financial Proposals from competent and eligible firms for the supply, implementation and support of an Integrated Software System.

Tender documents detailing the system and support requirements may be obtained from the Accountant at our Offices situated on the 5th Floor of Coffee Plaza, Exchange Lane, Off Haile Selassie Avenue, during official working days between 9:00am and 4:30pm from **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2008** upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Kshs.5,000/- (Five Thousand Shillings Only)** per set of tender documents, paid in cash or bankers cheques payable to "The Coffee Development Fund".
